- Each round will be played off your updated daily handicap (handicaps not frozen for event)
- Ties will be decided electronically on countback and as set out in the NZ Golf Club Manual.
- Scorecards must be completed and returned immediately after each round to the Tournament Committee in the Club Rooms/Office.
- Competitors must register with the Starters Office at least 30 minutes prior to their start time and to their starting tees at least 10 minutes before start time.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter the programme, competition divisions, format, dates and starting times.
- Any protest must be raised with the organizing committee within 30 minutes of finishing the round.
