# General Information

## **PERSONAL PROPERTY AND INSURANCE:**

The Club shall not be liable for loss of any property from the Club's premises or from motor vehicles in the car park. We recommend that you keep your vehicle locked at all times. Loss or damage to vehicles whilst parked in the car park is at the owner's responsibility.

*The Club is not liable for any damage or incident caused by a ball being hit into a vehicle parked in the car park or damage caused by a ball being hit into private property. Any incidents must be reported to the Manager immediately a round is completed.*

## **GOLF CARTS:**

The Board of Management at all times reserves the right to grant or revoke permission to use a motorcycle, golf cart or other forms of motorised transport on the Mount Maunganui Golf Course.

- Carts must be kept to the rough at all times with the following exceptions:
  - a. On non-restricted use days (dry days) cart users must comply with the 90° rule
  - b. On limited use days (wet days) where there is casual water, then carts may cross at high points along the fairway to avoid casual water
- Carts must in NO circumstances pass between the bunkers and the green and driven no closer than 5 meters from the green
- Carts must not drive over Tee Areas
- Carts must use cart paths around the teeing areas

## **CART STORAGE:**

Cart Shed storage is very limited; if you are interested please enquire at the office.

## **TRUNDLER STORAGE:**

Members requiring a place in the Storage area should enquire at the office for further information. Entry is by swipe card and access is restricted to the following times;

<b>SUMMER MONTHS (DAYLIGHT SAVING)</b>	6am to 9.30pm
<b>WINTER MONTHS</b>	7am to 8.30pm



## **SAFETY POLICY:**

This club has adopted safe working practices environment for the course, all players and employees are to note the following procedures to prevent injury to course staff and players from golf balls.

### **COURSE STAFF HAVE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES**

#### **Fairway and Rough maintenance:**

Players must wait for an approaching vehicle or mower to pass behind or out of range before playing their shot. Golfers may proceed if called on to play their shot by the operator.

#### **Greens maintenance:**

If a green is being worked upon by staff and the pin is not in the hole. Players are not to hit to the green until the flag is replaced and the green is cleared or they are called up by the staff.

#### **Other situations:**

Players must receive acknowledgement from course staff or other players who are in range before playing a shot.

#### **Spraying of Chemicals:**

Spraying of pesticides, fungicides and other chemicals is an essential part of course maintenance. Warning signs regarding spraying will be displayed on all starting tees when toxic chemicals are in use. A member or visitor is advised that it is at their own discretion to choose to use the course on days when chemicals have been applied.

#### **Personal Safety:**

A golf course can be a hazardous environment, all players and employees must maintain vigilance at all times to prevent harm or accidental injury to themselves or to others.

#### **Lightning strikes Precautions:**

Lightning strikes can kill people because thousands of volts of electric current are involved. A person struck by lightning will be seriously burnt and is likely to have stopped breathing.

Here is a summary of safety measures in the event of a Lightning Strike

- a. If caught in the open during an electrical storm, count the time gap between the lightning flash and the sound of thunder. Each second means the lightning strike is 1 km away. If the gap is less

than five seconds, take emergency precautions immediately.

These are as follows:

- Get into a car or building if possible.
  - If you are in the open, stay clear of wire fences, large trees, hill tops and metal tools or equipment.
- b. If operating a mower or tractor with ground contact implements, leave the machine and get at least 50 metres clear.
  - c. If in the open you are safer lying on the ground than standing up.

## **GOLFERS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE REASONABLE PRECAUTIONS TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF ALL PERSONS ON THE COURSE**

### **MEMBERSHIP CARDS:**

The 'Club Licence' requires that the membership card is carried by members at all times while on the Club's premises. Membership cards are also required to be shown on demand when on golf courses and to receive green fee concessions. Members who have guests entering the club house will need to sign their visitor into the club. This can be done in the visitors register located at the bar.

### **RECIPROCAL RIGHTS – CLUB HOUSE ONLY:**

The club may have reciprocal rights with other clubs throughout New Zealand. This will enable members to access other clubs by showing your Mount Maunganui Golf Club card. The list of reciprocal rights venues will be displayed on the clubs website.

### **HANDICAPPING:**

The regular return of *all* scores cards is required on completion of a round of golf. Scorecards are obtained automatically before each round at the Pro Shop after the player has entered his/her member ID number. Players are to check that all the correct details are printed on the card prior to teeing off. On completion of the round of golf the player's scorecard can be processed by the player and his / her partner on the touch screens located in the clubhouse.

### **PRACTISE ON THE COURSE:**

Practise on the course is permitted. A practise round may be played using no more than TWO balls.

## COMPLAINTS AND SUGGESTIONS:

These must be put in writing and forwarded to the Manager. They will be referred to the appropriate person or committee for action. Any issue relating to the course and / or course staff must be brought to the attention of the Manager and not discussed with any staff member / contractor.

# Hole in One

## **HOLE IN ONE – HOME COURSE**

*(These conditions only apply to members of the Mt Maunganui Golf Club).*

### **IN NO CASE WILL A CASH PAYMENT BE MADE TO THE MEMBER IN LIEU OF A SHOUT.**

- a) A shout shall be considered a drink all round for persons in the clubhouse who wish to partake at the invitation of the club.
- b) The 'Hole in One' shout must be taken on the day the 'Hole in One' is recorded or at the Manager's discretion.
- c) A drink consists of a standard order for a person e.g. single nip of spirits, a glass of beer, a glass of house wine or a glass of soft drink.
- d) Limit of \$150.00.
- e) When all persons have been served in accordance with the above conditions, the shout shall be considered complete.
- f) A trophy consisting of the mounted ball used to obtain the 'Hole in One' will be presented to the player at a later date.

## **HOLE IN ONE – AT ANOTHER COURSE**

The same rules as above apply. The player must present to the Manager, a signed GST receipt up to the value of \$150.00 for reimbursement. A trophy will be presented to the player at a later date.

# Reciprocal Rights

The Mount Maunganui Golf Club is a member of the Pacific Links Network which gives access to a number of clubs locally and throughout the world. All reciprocal arrangements are located on the clubs website [www.mountgolf.co.nz](http://www.mountgolf.co.nz) and should you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact the office.

## Speed of Play (Ready Golf)

The occurrence of “Slow Play” is a regular source of complaints from members. Almost every player has at some time expressed concern about the effects of Slow Play on their enjoyment of the game. The following are suggestions which could be of assistance in overcoming the problem.

1. Not being ready to play – **Play Ready Golf**.
2. Delays on tees and greens while marking the card. Always enter score on the card while waiting your turn at the tee.
3. Walk directly to your own ball, or level with it, and select club to be used while waiting for others to play their shots.
4. Unnecessary number of practice swings. Practice swings should be limited or eliminated.
5. Delays in locating lost balls. If, after a reasonable period and it is apparent you are holding up play, call next group through.
6. Discretion when going through a team that has lost a ball. If called through as in (5) but immediately afterwards the team ahead locates their lost ball and it is evident that play will proceed faster if they continue: signal them to go ahead. NOTE: The discretion is with the team called through not the players who were looking for the lost ball.
7. On the green unnecessary marking of the ball and not continuing to putt out. Study the line of your putt immediately as you reach the green. When it is your turn to putt, try and wherever possible putt right out. Marking the ball is sometimes necessary, but not always, and should be avoided.
8. Incorrect handling of the flag on the green. The player nearest the hole should attend the flag and then pass to the first player to hole out.
9. Leaving buggies around the green on the wrong side of the tee. Always place your buggy adjacent to the approach to the next tee.
10. **IMPORTANT: KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP OF PLAYERS IN FRONT.**
