COURSE & START TIMES:

Saturday - 1st June OMANU GOLF CLUB 10.30am.
Sunday - 2nd June MOUNT MAUNGANUI GOLF COURSE 8.30 am.

START TEES: Both Courses

Ladies - **Yellow tees** Silver/Bronze.
Men - **White Tees** Junior Division.
Men - **Blue Tees** Senior & Intermediate

DISTANCE MARKERS: **Mount.** To **FRONT** of the Green White 135m. Red 100m.
Omanu. To **MIDDLE** of the Green White 135m. Red 100m

TOURNAMENT & COMPETITION:

The Tournament is played over 36 holes Strokeplay - in all divisions.

The Competition is: 36 Holes Stableford - in each division

Gross winner prize in the men and women fields.

Divisions. (Provisional) Senior Men +5 to 8.9 (24) Intermediate Men 9.0 to 15.5 (33)
Junior Men 15.6 + (38)

Women (33) Prizes in 2 divisions for top 3 prizes 4th on across women's field.

NOTE: Divisions will be determined based on the "Mount Maunganui" handicap index
As at Wednesday 28th May 2019.

TWO'S: Available from the Pro Shop of each club.

SCORE CARDS:

Score Cards will be handed to you on your starting tee for each round.

Please return your completed & signed score card PROMPTLY to the Officials in the Clubhouse.
Incomplete or incorrect cards will disqualify the player from the competition.

PLACING: Both Courses. - 1 club length on own mown fairway.

PACE OF PLAY: "Players Responsibility". **"PLAY READY GOLF"**.

Course Marshalls will be monitoring the "Pace of Play" to ensure that the field moves quickly.

Penalty for Breach of "Pace of Play" the playing four will receive a verbal warning and each subsequent warning will incur a 1 and then a 2 stroke penalty and be disqualified for a 4th incident

TIES.

If there is more than one winning total the winner will be determined by DOT Golf (count-back).

ARTIFICIAL MEASURING DEVICES:

A player may use a measuring device designed to measure or gauge distance only.

Use of any device that does not comply with this requirement will disqualify the player from the tournament.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY:

<i>Play temporarily suspended</i>	-	<i>3 consecutive 10 second blasts of the siren. May only finish the hole being played.</i>
<i>Dangerous Situation</i>	-	<i>1 continuous 30 second blast of the siren. Mark the ball position & return to clubhouse.</i>
<i>Resume Play</i>	-	<i>1 Prolonged blast of the siren.</i>

In the event of a cancellation of a round or part thereof, the Match Committee shall determine "the Competition" for that round and the ruling may apply to one or both courses.

MATCH COMMITTEE:

The decisions of the Match Committee for each course shall be final in all matters.

LOCAL RULES:

Refer to the score card of each club and Local Rules Notice Board otherwise the Rules of Golf apply.

Note: *To avoid unnecessary delays*

Rule 3.3 enables a player to play a second ball if in doubt as to any procedure or ruling.
(A definitive ruling is to be obtained from the Committee on the completion of the round).
Washouts in Bunkers - where caused by water run-off resulting from rain or irrigation to be treated as G.U.R. (Ball to be dropped in the bunker).

NOTICES:

Raffle: *Each Club may run a Raffle.
Drawn prior to prize giving and announced at Prize Giving.*

Hole in One: *A prize will be awarded for the first recorded "Hole in One".*

Prize Giving: *Expected to commence at Mount Maunganui from approx. 2.00 to 2.30 pm - or when all scores have been processed.*
