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CONDITIONS FOR 2016 GRANT CLEMENTS MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT

1. ENTRIES;

Entries are invited from amateurs golfers who are financial members (with playing rights) with a handicap computed in accordance with the handicapping and course rating system of NZ Golf or their National Golf Association. **Preference** will be given to those players eligible to be selected to represent NZ Golf. Late or incomplete entries and/or those without fees will not be accepted.

2. CLOSE OF ENTRIES;

Completed Official Entry forms accompanied by the entry fee **MUST** reach the office of the Mount Maunganui Golf Club (Inc.), 15 Fairway Ave, Mt Maunganui not later than 5.00pm on Friday 22nd January 2016. **Entry fee will not be refunded to entrants who withdraw after closing date.** Entry fee payments of those with a **higher handicap index** will not be processed until after the closing date. The entry fee of those excluded will be returned. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without being required to give a reason for so refusing.

3. SIZE OF FIELD;

Entries for the tournament will be limited to 90 ninety (up to 78 MEN & 12 WOMEN). Entries in excess of 90 in total, (those with the highest handicap effective 18th January) may be eliminated to reduce the field to a total of 90.

The Committee reserves the right to increase or decrease the numbers of entries of men or women and the total to a maximum of 96.

4. RULES OF PLAY;

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and local rules approved by the Tournament Committee of the Mount Maunganui Golf Club (Inc).

5. REGISTRATION;

Players are required to register in person at the Tournament Office on Friday 19th February 2016, between 10am and 5pm at Mt Maunganui Golf Club or no later than 30 minutes prior to the players appointed 1st round tee off time on Saturday 20th February 2016.

6. STARTING TIMES, POSTPONEMENTS;

Competitors must be prepared to play all rounds of the event as determined by the committee in the event cancellation or postponement of a round.

7. COMMITTEE;

The Tournament Committee will decide all disputes, will be responsible for all arrangements and may if necessary postpone any event or alter the order of events or starting times. The decision of the Committee on these matters shall be final. "The Tournament Committee" is the Committee in charge of the competition appointed by the Mount Maunganui Golf Club (Inc).

8. CARTS;

The use of motorised golf carts is NOT permitted.

9. BALLS;

It is a condition of the Tournament that only those brands of ball published in the current Lists of Conforming 1.68 Balls, which have been tested by the R & A or the USGA and found to conform with the Rules, may be used in the Tournament. The penalty for use of a brand not listed is DISQUALIFICATION.

10. DRAW;

A draw for play for Saturday 20th February 2016 shall be made and published on the Club's Website; www.mountgolf.co.nz on approximately 1st February 2016 under the "Tournament" link and/or at the Club House, Professional Shop, Office or Tee Booking.

11. DISPUTE;

Any disputes or protests must be lodged with the Tournament Controller within 10 minutes after the completion of the round and the Tournament Committee's decision on all points, disputes or protests shall be final.

12. TEE-OFF;

Competitors **MUST** be on the tee, ready to start, 10 minutes before their advertised time. Competitors not ready to start will be dealt with under the Rules of Golf, Rule 6.3a (two strokes on first hole).

13. TIES;

Ties for the Grant Clements Rosebowl and the men & women's Grant Clements Memorial Trophies shall be decided by hole by hole sudden death play-off, the first of which shall be the 18th, and at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

All other ties will be decided by the Tournament Committee using countback.

14. DRIVING CLUBS;

The Driver a competitor uses must be a 'Conforming Driver' as defined in the list issued by the R & A Ltd.

15. SLOW PLAY;

Players are required to ensure slow play is avoided.

Marshals will be on the course to monitor slow play and if a warning to a player is not heeded a two stroke penalty will be imposed. A repeated offence will result in the player's disqualification.

16. ARTIFICIAL DEVICES;

During the competition a player may use any device designed to indicate "course distance measurements" only. Any Device that measures other than distance must not be used.

17. PRACTICE ROUNDS;

Practice rounds may be available 'Free of charge' on Thursday 18th February 2016 late or Friday 20th February 2016 from about 3pm. - the tees will be managed by the Pro Shop -

Note that Green Keepers will be preparing the course for the tournament and have right of way.

18. DRESS;

Competitors are especially requested to maintain the Club "Standard of dress" requirements.

Jeans, shorts without ankle length socks and rubber thongs are not acceptable. Collared shirts are required in the Clubhouse.
